Personal Data may be freely provided by the User, or, in the case of Usage Data, collected automatically when using this Application.

Unless otherwise specified, all Data requested by this Application is mandatory. Failure to provide this Data may make it impossible for this Application to provide its Service. In cases where this Application indicates some Data as optional, Users are free not to communicate such Data, without this having any consequences on the availability or on its operation. Users who have doubts about which data are mandatory are encouraged to contact the Owner.

Any use of Cookies - or other tracking tools - by this Application or by the owners of third-party services used by this Application, unless otherwise specified, is intended to provide the Service requested by the User, in addition to the other purposes described in this document and in the Cookie Policy, if available.

The User assumes responsibility for the Personal Data of third parties obtained, published or shared through this Application and guarantees that he or she has the right to communicate or disseminate them, freeing the Owner from any liability to third parties.

Method and place of processing of the Data collected Method of processing measures The Owner takes appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification or destruction of Personal Data.

The processing is carried out using IT and/or telematic tools, with organizational methods and with logic strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Owner, in some cases, other parties involved in the operation of this Application (administrative, commercial, marketing, legal, system administration) or external parties (such as third-party technical service providers, mail carriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communications agencies) may have access to the Data, also appointed, if necessary, as Data Processors by the Owner. Legal basis for processing The Owner processes Personal Data relating to the User if one of the following applies: • the User has given consent for one or more specific purposes; Note: under some jurisdictions the Owner may be allowed to process Personal Data without the User's consent or any other of the legal bases specified below, until the User objects ("opts-out") of such processing. However, this does not apply, whenever the processing of Personal Data is regulated by European data protection law;

Retention period

The Data is processed and stored for as long as required by the purposes for which it was collected.

Therefore:

- Personal Data collected for purposes related to the performance of a contract between the Owner and the User will be retained until such contract has been fully performed.
- Personal Data collected for purposes related to the legitimate interest of the Owner will be retained until such interest is fulfilled. The User may obtain further information regarding the legitimate interest pursued by the Owner in the relevant sections of this document or by contacting the Owner.

When the processing is based on the User's consent, the Owner may retain Personal Data for a longer period until such consent is revoked. Furthermore, the Owner may be obliged to retain Personal Data for a longer period in compliance with a legal obligation or by order of an authority.

At the end of the retention period, the Personal Data will be deleted. Therefore, upon expiration of such period, the right of access, deletion, rectification and the right to portability of the Data can no longer be exercised.

User Rights

Users may exercise certain rights with reference to the Data processed by the Owner.

In particular, the User has the right to:

- withdraw consent at any time. The User may withdraw consent to the processing of their Personal Data previously expressed.

- lodge a complaint. The User can lodge a complaint with the competent data protection supervisory authority or take legal action.
