### **ANEMOSCOPE WINDMILL**

Located on the wonderful Santorini Island, Anemoscope Windmill dominates the Aegean Sea, enjoying a panorama known to be among the most beautiful in the world.

Anemoscope Windmill is a centuries-old mill, a unique place, rich in history and tradition, part of the architectural heritage of the island and of the medieval town of Pyrgos Kallistis, one of the oldest and still authentic villages where you can rediscover the real Greek slow rhythms.

### **The Windmill Villa**

Anemoscope Windmill is a 1700s building of approximately 180 m2 renovated after the 1956 earthquake with its authentic stones and with the restrictions that only a centuries-old building can have.

Internally, traditional and hand-decorated pieces are expertly mixed with innovation, making it an elegant boutique villa.

The six-seater bedrooms offer the experience of a unique flavour. In the highest double bedroom, the view is offered by a 360° circular window and overlooks the Aegean Sea, the entire island and the caldera.

Capable of taking you back in time: the relaxed atmosphere manages to transport guests into an analogue dimension, leaving behind all the frenzy of everyday life in an almost dreamlike experience.

In the outdoor spaces, the large Jacuzzi directly overlooks the caldera offering the opportunity to taste the famous local wine in front of a breathtaking, intimate and suggestive panorama.

The outdoor barbecue and the indoor kitchen offer the possibility of spectacular dinners in front of the lights of an island whose perimeter slides into the water forming an exciting natural scenario.

**TRADITIONAL WINDMILL & BOUTIQUE VILLA**

Ideal for a quick escape from the city but also for a long leisure stay, it offers private parking and it is open all year round.

## **Location**

Located in Santorini, precisely in Pyrgos Kallistis, a village declared a protected settlement in 1995, the former capital of Santorini that is one of the 5 fortified settlements.

The village is located a few kilometers from the port and the airport in the center of the island, an ideal place to discover it.

Positioned at the entrance to the village, at the highest point, the windmill dominates it, offering privacy but at the same time just a few steps away from the life of the village and the typical local and traditional restaurants and taverns.

To reach the castle it is easy to get lost in the labyrinth of alleys of Pyrgos, specially created to confuse the enemies who tried to conquer it.

Its churches, the Monastery, the small art galleries of the city with the white and blue colors of Greece enchant the visitor, exciting him until the arrival of the underground passage.

But it is Orthodox Easter that offers an exciting insight into Greek rites, the village is covered in torches and large crosses are erected on the castle creating an evocative and spectacular atmosphere, beyond the classic sunny but windy Cycladic summer days.

## **Activity**

Anemoscope Windmill aims to help guests immerse themselves in everything the island has to offer: crater cruises, private tours, water sports, volcano trekking, but also massages and relaxation, romantic dinners, cultural visits, tastings of the famous local wine and other memorable trips.
