Masseria II Frantoio

Masseri Puglia, Italy

Marvellous Puglian dinners, gloriously eclectic interiors, mysterious gardens... This organic masseria really is special. An old, white house clear-cut against a blue sky, mysterious gardens, the scent of jasmine – and private beaches five kilometres away.

"Food, glorious food. Local, seasonal, grown on the farm. Pugliese recipes, Pugliese wines (many organic) and a sense of theatre about every meal. Armando — passionate, engaging drum-beater for Slow Food and the role it plays in community, culture, life itself — glides between tables with stories about each dish. Rosalba, his wife, quietly works her magic from the kitchen. A real Slow Food experience."

Armando and Rosalba spent a year restoring this 17th-century house. Rosalba specialises in Puglian dishes accompanied by good local wines; Armando rings the courtyard bell at 8.30: the feast begins, either in the arched dining room or outside in the candlelit courtyard. Armando is deeply passionate about his totally organic masseria, surrounded by olive groves and with a view of the sea; Silvana is on hand ensuring you bask in comfort.


