

RESORT REPORT Shining the spotlight on the best destinations





Located in its own private bay on the Aegean Coast of Turkey, close to the popular holiday city of Bodrum. It is secluded enough to enjoy the solitude of the area without feeling too far away from civilisation and outside nightlife.

What's the appeal?

A grown-up resort without the long-haul flight. Tucked away on the Turkish Riviera, on an untouched part of the peninsula, this hotel offers everything you would expect from a five-star

establishment, including tailored wellness packages and multiple dining options.

What makes it special?

Between the Shisha Sommelier, mountain meditation, candlelit yoga and adults-only beach, finding something that doesn't set the hotel apart is difficult. There is also a private marina and marina butler, along with a private day cruiser if you wish to see the sights from the sea and explore the wonderful coastline

Six different dining options are on offer, including Barbarossa, an Aegean fish speciality restaurant, and the casual Pool, which serves light lunchtime snacks and cocktails by the hotel's main infinity pool. Sublime Sundeck - a hip hang out that is adults only - enjoys a live DJ set from 5pm onwards.

The 5,500-square-metre spa complex is home to luxury treatment rooms, an indoor pool, a whirlpool, Hammam,





sauna and steam rooms. The balancing of body and mind is also on the agenda, with resident water-healer and therapist Deniz Susever on hand.

Our favourite room

Two presidential suites of 201 square metres are available – one designed with Asian influences and the other with the charm of the Ottoman era. Both suites enjoy their own 24-hour butlers. in-room Jacuzzi baths. and amazing views out onto the Aegean Sea.

How to get there

Flights to Bodrum via various international carriers make arriving by plane easy. Private jets are also catered for. The airport can arrange a Mercedes people carrier to take you to the hotel, or a helicopter transfer is also available.
