## Discovering the Colonna Pevero Hotel in Porto Cervo

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The Emerald Coast, with its varied landscape, offers several extremely prestigious hotels that are exclusive and refined: adjectives related to their famous names, the services they offer and their geographical location, etc. The Colonna Pevero Hotel is one of these. Located near one of the loveliest and most exclusive bays on the coast the Pevero, from which the hotel takes its name, it is also a synonym of quality, privilege, exclusivity and glamour. The genius loci of the home is made up of a combination of fine and skilfully created spaces: the little square (typical of this area of Sardinia) which reproduces the more famous ones of Porto Cervo and Porto Rotondo in miniature, and the communicating swimming pools with stone walkways and small fountains, which are a little paradise to be enjoyed during the day for moments of relaxation and tranquillity. Almost all the rooms have been designed to have a sea view, which seems obvious, but is not always the rue in equally famous structures. For the most discerning international clients there are various types of rooms, with 9 suites, a Royal Suite and a truly impressive Presidential Suite. Although it is a top class structure, it has a gentle, familiar and relaxing

environment, without the constraints of some luxury hotels, which can be extremely strict during the summer holiday period, which is dedicated above all to rest and personal care. The Colonna Pevero has two winning features. The first is its excellent restaurant, *Zafferano*, which offers elegant designer cuisine, very much linked to local tradition, a great choice of fine wines, many from prestigious local wineries and fish that is skilfully cooked and cleverly presented each day on the menu.

The second important one is the professionalism and courtesy of the staff, from the manger (who is more a gracious hostess than a manager) to the house staff who are seldom seen but are visible in the attention to detail with which the hotel is run. I was able to immerse myself completely in the Colonna Pevero, by sea, by land and even by sky... thanks to a splendid helicopter ride.
